Current School Opening Times



**ALL classes start at 08:45am
and end the day at 3:20pm**

Children who are late for school will be marked as such, which could be flagged up as a concern during our attendance monitoring. If your child is late on a regular basis, they then miss out on a vital routine, which helps them settle into the school day and be ready to start learning. If they are late, this disturbs the smooth start of the day for all.



Reporting Absence

If your child is absent from school you can either telephone the school on 01522 868287 or send an email to enquiries@swinderby.lincs.sch.uk before 9.15am to inform us that your child is ill. Our new

phone lines mean you can leave a voicemail to report your child's absence by pressing option 2.

Absences must be reported each day your child is absent.

If your child is absent due to sickness or diarrhoea, they will need to be clear of all the symptoms for 48 hours before returning to school.



Attendance Every student. Every day.

It is vital that your children get the best possible education going forward so please send your children to school. Attendance is now **compulsory** and holidays in term time will NOT be authorised. Our normal attendance policy will now apply, and Fixed Penalty Notices may be issued.

As a school, we need to meet the target of 95.9%, which is the national average. We can only do this if parents support us fully and if we all understand the importance of NOT taking term time, holidays or absences from school. Attendance will be monitored each half term. In line with the new Government policy, an even greater emphasis will be placed on attendance.

Holidays in Term Time *IMPORTANT*****

Following instruction from the Lincolnshire County Council Attendance Team, the Governors have approved a new school Attendance policy. The school will now be fining and issuing Fixed Penalty Notices for holidays taken in term time and will be rigorous in its pursuit of attendance. The school has previously tried to take an understanding approach towards holidays in term time; however, this will no longer be the case. Uniform

The school is keen to ensure that our children look smart and wear their uniform with pride. PE kits are part of the school uniform

NO patterned or logoed (except school logo) T-shirts. This includes PE kits

The school promotes sustainability and reuse of uniform. Donations of outgrown uniform are welcomed and there is a free clothing rail readily available in school for parents to access uniform.

Jewellery – there should be NO jewellery worn in school. For those with pierced ears – studs are to be worn ONLY but these need to be removed/taped up on PE days

PE Kit



Long hair **MUST** be tied up for PE and NO earrings are to be worn.

PE KIT WORN MUST BE IN LINE WITH THE SCHOOL UNIFORM – PALE BLUE/WHITE plain or school logo t-shirt, plain black/navy jogging bottoms or shorts and school sweatshirt/ cardigan or plain royal blue sweatshirt. Trainers or plimsolls, as plain as possible.

We will be strict about this and if your child wears anything different to this, we will ask them to change. Please support us with this so that your child does not feel uncomfortable. WE WILL not accept the wearing of sports tops or football shirts.

Online Safety



E-safety – electronic safety – is all about keeping ourselves safe, maintaining our privacy and protecting our rights in the digital world.

We all need to be aware of potential e-safety issues with all our digital devices and forms of digital communication not just computers and the internet. Computers, laptops, tablets (iPads, Kindles etc.), digital cameras, games consoles (Xbox, Wii, iPod touch, Nintendo DS etc.) smart televisions, mobile phones, texts and email are ALL part of the digital world.

Social networking sites such as Facebook and Twitter, and video sharing sites such as YouTube are valuable in allowing us to maintain communication with family and friends worldwide. However, parents and children should abide by the age restrictions on such sites and carefully set their privacy settings.

Just as in the real world, we need children to be aware of stranger danger and bullying (cyber-bullying) in the digital world. We need our children to recognise when it is happening and were to seek help.

At school, we educate children about e-Safety in ICT lessons, but it is important that parents know some key e-Safety tips too. Below are some links to resources to help support parents and children with all aspects of e-safety.

Clothing Bank

The Rag-Bag clothing bank is outside the school. If you have any unwanted clothing items, please bag them up and place them in the large green bin outside the black gates.

The 'Rag Bag' recycling scheme has been developed to provide regular fundraising for schools in the UK.

The scheme increases awareness about textile recycling and by increasing recycling rates we can help the environment by ensuring less material goes to landfill.

Music

Private music lessons are also available in most instruments through the Lincolnshire Music Service. If anyone is interested, please do let us know and we can

request the Music Service get in touch with you. Piano lessons will continue to be on a Monday afternoon.



Mobile Phones

Children should not be bringing mobile phones into school unless there are exceptional circumstances – going home on the bus for example. If a phone is brought into school, it needs to be handed to the office on arrival and it will be kept safe until the end of the day.



Parking

Please could all parents ensure that they are mindful of not parking in the school bus bay when dropping off in the morning or collecting in the afternoon. For the safety of all the children, getting on and off the bus it is important this area is kept clear. The bus bay is now clearly marked.

Also, could we remind parents to continue being courteous to our neighbours and ensure we're not blocking any access or driveways. Please, show you care, park elsewhere; we've got the ideal facility (**Park & Stride**) just five-minute walk away at the Village Hall.

Speed Limit

Could we ask all parents to ensure that they are keeping to the 30mph maximum speed limit throughout the village. Drop off and pick up times are exceptionally busy, and this can create further driving hazards within the village. Around the school zone, it is suggested that a speed limit of 20mph is more suitable during these times.

SCHOOL BUS

Please could parents remind their children that good behaviour is required on the school bus and check that the mobiles being brought with them are having appropriate use – there should be no Snapchat, for example. This does have an age restriction of 13yrs and above. If children misbehave on their journey to and from school, this could result in their bus pass being revoked by LCC and an alternative method of getting to and from school will need to be sought.



Free School Meals

With effect from September 2018, a new system to process Free School Meals was introduced, whereby parents and guardians will need to apply online. We would encourage **ALL** parents & guardians to apply.

Lunchboxes

According to NHS choices, a balanced lunchbox should contain:

- Starchy foods like bread, rice, potatoes or pasta
- Protein foods like meat, fish, eggs or beans
- A dairy item, like cheese or yogurt
- Vegetables or salad and a portion of fruit

As a school we encourage the above suggestions but also allow a small chocolate bar (i.e. a Penguin/Kit Kat) or a small piece of cake.

However, there are some items that are **NOT** allowed in school, these include:

- Bags of sweets (of any size)
- Large chocolate bars (Mars, Wispas etc.)
- Nuts or nut-based products
- Eggs

NUT ALLERGY

We are a nut free school due to allergies within school. Please ensure that nuts or nut-based products are NOT included in your child's lunchbox. If your child is found to have these, we will have to remove from their lunchbox. Thank you for your understanding.



Letters Home

We send all letters that don't need printing out via email. We're happy to receive replies/responses via email to the School Office – enquiries@swinderby.lincs.sch.uk

Letters that require you to send in a reply slip are sent home as a hard copy, but we are keeping these to a minimum in order to help promote a greener environment.

Permission Slips

We appreciate the children sometimes have a lot of letters to bring home, but we try to keep this to a minimum by emailing copies home where possible and putting notifications on our Facebook page. However, for those letters that do have to go home and require a permission slip returning, could we ask that children are provided with a plastic folder to keep them safe and contained on the journey from class room to home and vice versa. That way it tries to limit any information that could potentially be lost in transit.
